

TOWN OF MINONG
ORDINANCE TO REGULATE STOPPING, STANDING, OR
PARKING OF VEHICLES ON TOWN ROAD
ORDINANCE # 27

The Town Board of the Town of Minong, Washburn County, Wisconsin, has the specific authority under s.349.13, WI statutes to adopt this Ordinance.

THE PURPOSE OF THIS ORDINANCE IS TO REGULATE RESTRICTIONS AND LIMITATIONS ON THE FOLLOWING ROAD: _____

This ordinance, adopted by a majority of the town board on a roll call vote with a quorum present and voting and proper notice having been given, provides for the regulation of the stopping, standing, or parking of vehicles on certain town roads within the Town of Minong as follows:

- A. Pursuant to s. 349.11 WI statutes, effective on _____ 2012, parking restrictions on the following road _____ shall be restricted or modified for the entire road or within the following sections of said road. _____.
- B. Pursuant to s 349.11 (5) WI Statutes the town chairperson, or his or her designee, shall place the appropriate traffic signs at the above- described locations on or before the effective date of this ordinance.
- C. No person may operate any vehicle on the above-noted town road in violation of the above-noted stopping, standing, or parking restrictions and limitations. . Any vehicle in violation may be towed at the expense of the owner or operator of that vehicle , and shall be subject to a forfeiture of \$ _____.

This ordinance is effective on _____ 2012 after the clerk has properly posted this ordinance as required under s. 60.80, WI Statutes.
