SUPPORTING WEEKEND VOTING IN THE TOWN OF MINONG

RESOLUTION # 60

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the Town Board of the Town of Minong sees the need, and for this reason has created the following Resolution for the Town of Minong opposing the proposal of weekend voting.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that due to the fact that the population of the Town of Minong does not merit for any reason an extension in voting hours from the 14 (fourteen) required hours on Tuesdays in Novembers to 48 (forty eight) hours on Saturday and Sundays in November. And that the Town of Minong is already required by State Statutes to allow "no reason" absentee voting at all elections.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Town board of the Town of Minong feels that this is an unnecessary allocation of tax dollars.

SO BE IT RESOLVED THEN that the Town Board of the Town of Minong has voted 5 to 0 to go on record of being opposed to any legislation supporting weekend voting in municipalities with a population under 5,000 electors.

This decision being made by the Minong Town Board at the Town Board Meeting held February 9, 2009.
